Curriculum focus of PPG spending in 2015/16

For children to make expected or better progress in numeracy, reading and writing

To raise the self-esteem of children in need of positive reinforcement and pastoral guidance

For children to receive the same opportunities as others in terms of music tuition, school trips, equipment/uniform and extra- curricular activities

Measuring the impact of PPG spending

100% received TA support

95% achieved expected or better attainment in reading

95% achieved expected or better attainment in writing (those who didn't were SEN or EAL or both)

90% achieved expected or better attainment in maths (1 child also SEN)

64% of children requested and received music tuition

100% of the children attended school trips & took part in extra-curricular activities

27% of the children took part in 'Turnabout' / Positive Play

31% of the children received 1:1 tutor support
