## A message from the Board of the Directors of the Holy Trinity Catholic Multi Academy Company

### St. Anne's Catholic Primary School

Parents will be aware of the arrangements for the leadership of St. Anne's until the end of the Summer Term. The Headship will be advertised nationally on the 31<sup>st</sup> January 2017 with the aim to appoint for September 2017. Staff and parents will be kept informed of any further developments.

### St. Austin's and St. Mary's Catholic Primary Schools

Mrs. Corbett has been appointed as Executive Head of St. Austin's and St. Mary's Schools effective 1st January 2017. The Executive Headteacher in partnership with the Board of Directors and the Academy Committees of the two schools will create the strategic environment to enable each school to achieve their educational goals and priorities.

The Executive Headteacher will lead the newly created role of HEAD of SCHOOL in each of the two schools and they will be responsible for day to day running of the school.

Following a consultation paper to be issued early January for the leadership team of both schools the two new HEAD of SCHOOL positions will be advertised for each school by mid-January. The position of St. Austin's is "ring fenced" due to current acting head situation and the St. Mary's position will be open to all teachers within the Holy Trinity Academy. End of January / early February 2017 interviews and appointments will take place. Latest mid-February 2017 there will be an announcement / communication to all parents, staff and Academy Representative Committees of the successful candidates.
